

Chaplaincy...is it for you?

As you discern God's call to ministry, The Presbyterian Federal Chaplaincies invites you to consider a calling to use your gifts as a chaplain. Chaplains are needed to provide vital spiritual support and life-sustaining pastoral care within the Federal Bureau of Prisons, the Veteran's Administration Hospital system or one of the military branches.



The Presbyterian Federal Chaplaincies recruits, equips, sustains, and celebrates the men and women who serve as chaplains within our federal institutions. The Presbyterian Federal Chaplaincies include the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, the Cumberland Presbyterian Church in America, and the Korean Presbyterian Church Abroad.

All religious ministry professionals serving as chaplains in federal institutions require an endorsement from denomination. The PFC fulfills this requirement for our four member denominations.

Chaplaincy Opportunities

DEPARTMENT OF VETERAN'S AFFAIRS (VA) HOSPITAL

CHAPLAINCY: Provide complete religious ministry to veteran patients and Families in accordance with their needs and desires. Address religious, spiritual, moral, and ethical problems of patients, ministering to newly admitted, pre- and post-operative patients, and the critically ill.

FEDERAL BUREAU OF PRISONS

CHAPLAINCY: Provide a comprehensive program of spiritual welfare and religious guidance for inmates in a Federal correctional setting.



ARMY, NAVY, OR AIR FORCE

CHAPLAIN: (Active Duty, Reserve or National Guard). Care for the spiritual well-being of Service members and their Families regardless of their religious backgrounds, ministering to their needs wherever and whenever they are needed.

CHAPLAIN CANDIDATE:

Opportunity for seminary and other professional religious school students to evaluate their compatibility and potential for commissioning as a military Chaplain.

CIVIL AIR PATROL CHAPLAINCY:

Voluntary position with the CAP – Air Force Auxiliary. Provides chaplain services to search and rescue crews and participates in character development opportunities for youth.
